FHA Mortgage Loans Increase At Rapid Pace

Current reports received from the Federal Housing Administration by C. G. Bray, local district senior evaluator, show the number of financial institutions making loans under terms of the FHA insured mortgage plan is increasing at the rate of ninety a month.

As of September 30th, there were 5,851 active mortgages in the United States, of which 174 were in California. An additional 312 approved mortgages also are listed in California.

Commercial banks, including national and state banks and trust companies, have financed the greatest number of mortgages accepted for insurance, accounting for 60.5 per cent of the total number, or 127,102 mortgages amounting to \$506,189,004.

Of the remaining number, building and loan associations accounted for 16.5 per cent; mortgage companies, 9.5 per cent; insurance companies, 7.4 per cent; savings banks, 3.2 per cent, and all other types of institutions, 3.1 per cent.

The FHA on September 30th had accepted 210,013 net mortgages, totaling \$850,174,674, for insurance.
